COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- All contestants in all divisions must be U.S. Citizens
- School-age children must be enrolled in a public, private, charter, or approved home school as of pageant date.
- Contestants in school must be in good academic standing with no attendance or significant discipline issues.
- There will be one winner crowned in each age division with a 1st runner-up in each group. The winner will be the contestant with the highest points in the required phases of competition.
- The judges decision is final. Score sheets are available to contestants and will be emailed or texted after the pageant.
- A Photogenic Winner will be selected in each division for those who choose to enter. This competition will be scored separately and will NOT be included in the overall scores for each contestant. Recommendations are for a natural looking head shot of the contestant. Photos will be judged on beauty, expression, and personality. Please turn in the photo(s) at the registration table when you arrive. Label your photo(s) with name and age division. No more than 2 photos may be entered. The photos will be available for return after the pageant. There is a \$10 entry fee for extra photos. **This is an optional category.**
- Pageant day will begin with registration from 9:00am to collect Photogenic entries and for contestants to have a walk through on the stage. Contestants should arrive with hair/makeup ready. A dressing room area is provided but there will be limited time to change clothes. Competition will begin promptly at 11:00am. Entry fees for “No-shows” are **non-refundable. All entire fees are non-refundable but can be used for future pageants. NO REFUNDS**
- Each contestant will receive 1 complimentary admission ticket for their backstage helper. Tickets will be available at the door for \$5.00 per person (under 3 is admitted free).
